

Exploring Anatomy with Innovative Medical Visualization Technology

With your investment, the Ladue Education Foundation funded Dr. Allen Weltig's grant request for an Anatomage Table—a fully interactive, 3D virtual digital learning tool for students enrolled in LHWHS Biomedical and Anatomy and Physiology classes.

Using the Anatomage Table's touch interactive screen and sophisticated 3D anatomy visualization software, students can rotate, explore, and dissect human and animal cadavers in any direction. This innovative system


serves as an alternative to the dissection of real specimens, promoting resource conscientious and ethical use of living organisms.

"Even in the short time we've had the Anatomage Table, students have been able to see authentic, 3D representations of the anatomy they were learning in class. They not only see the real anatomy on the cadavers but are able to manipulate and interact with it in a way that brings real application to their learning," adds Dr. Weltig.

Comparative Anatomy students utilize the table to study the canine cardiovascular system, following the round-trip path of a blood cell between the heart and an organ. Students then track the same blood cell in a pig to determine the similarities and differences. Biology classes use the table as well, as teachers can enhance instruction of a frog dissection unit.

A subsequent grant from the LEF for a software update provides students with access to new clinical imaging (CT and MRI scans) of not only human, but also animal species, allowing for new explorations of both anatomy and disease.


LADUE HORTON WATKINS HIGH SCHOOL PIANO LAB

A new Industrial Technology course provides real-world learning, allowing students to apply math, science, engineering, and design skills by building a tiny home. STEAM WEEK - HAGERMAN THE SCIENCE WIZARD



LADUE MIDDLE SCHOOL OUTDOOR CLASSROOM






